pages. It is not responsible for the content, accuracy, appropriateness or availability of external links from its pages and assumes no responsibility for damages,

howsoever caused, sought by customers or third parties arising from its provision of

Internet services.

Customers are responsible for assessing the quality and validity of information found

on the Internet.

As with other Library services, children's access to and use of the Internet is the

responsibility of the parent or guardian.

FILTERING The Library provides access to both filtered and unfiltered workstations. All customers

have access to all workstations. Filtered workstations have software that attempts to block sites that contain sexually explicit or hate speech material. The Library assumes no responsibility in the event the filter is not 100% effective. Filtering software does

not supplant the need for parental guidance.

PROHIBITIONS Customers are prohibited from:

 Attempting to gain unauthorized access to computer operating systems and computer files, passwords, or data belonging to others.

 Damaging or altering the hardware and software components of any computer system.

LEGISLATION
