Role of the Library Board

- The Library Board is a **statutory board**, created by the Municipality, pursuant to the Public Libraries Act.
- Board members are appointed for a **4-year term** concurrent with the Council's term of office.
- Our role is to govern the affairs of the Library, provide **oversight and accountability**, and advance the Library's mission and impact.
- •The Board acts as an **advocate in support of community interest** and ensures that the community's requests regarding library services are addressed through the planning and budgeting process, and
- •We ensure that Municipal **Council is informed** of the library's role in the community, its accomplishments, needs and future direction.



MPL launched the Lendery in collaboration with York Region Sustainability Office and York Region Makers offering household equipment, tools and sports equipment.








Innovation in Library Lending







Library Branches




Looking Ahead to Continuing our Recovery

- Community demand for our summer camp programs runs high high – on Day 1 of registration, the camps were 99% full.





